Team > Remote > Push... Use Repository URL and Bitbucket username/password Select checkbox for master local and remote branches, choose yes if asked to track

Then, on any other computers or team-mate computers...

Team > Remote > Clone...

Pull to get the latest version of the source code...

Team > Remote > Pull from Upstream

Edit source code

Team > Commit... Enter a meaningful commit message

Team > Remote > Push to Upstream
